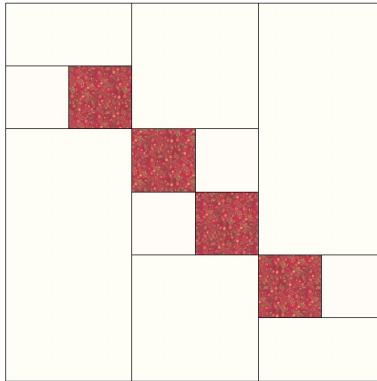


Block Four



Make Eight, 12 1/2" unfinished

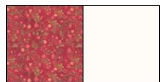
Fabric Requirements

5" Red

- Cut two 2 1/2" strips by WOF

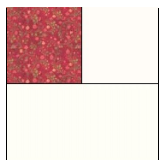
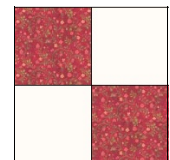
36.5" Background

- Cut two 2 1/2" strips by WOF
- Cut seven 4 1/2" strips by WOF. From these strips, cut:
 - (16) 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
 - (16) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
 - (16) 4 1/2" squares



Sew a red strip to a white strip and press to the dark. Make two sets. Crosscut these strip sets every 2 1/2" to make 32 two part blocks.

From half of these units, make 8 four-patches. Sew a 4 1/2" square to the top and bottom of this four patch, making sure the red square is in the upper left hand corner. Press to the background square.



Sew a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" background rectangle to the remaining two part units, again making sure that the red square is in the upper left hand corner. Sew a 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" background rectangle to the top of this unit. Press to the background square.

Sew your block in three columns, matching the diagram above. Press.
