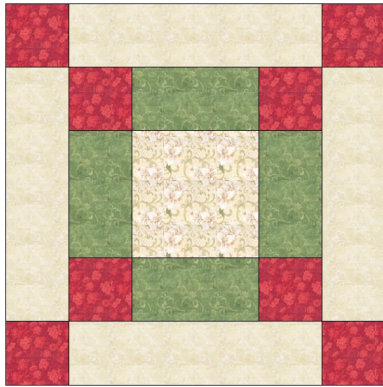
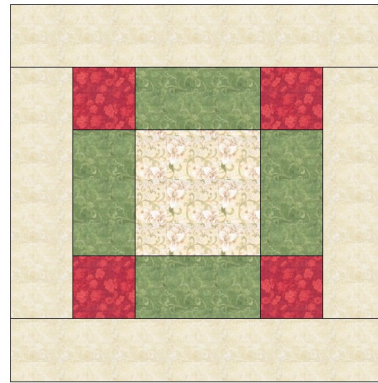


Block One



Block 1A - Make 12
12 1/2" unfinished



Block 1B - Make 2
12 1/2" unfinished

Fabric Requirements

9" Amaryllis

- Cut two 4 1/2 strips by width of fabric (WOF), then crosscut into (14) 4 1/2" squares.

20" Red

- Cut eight 2 1/2" strips by WOF

18" Green

- Cut two 4 1/2" strips by WOF. Cross cut into (28) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles .
- Cut two 4 1/2" strips by WOF.

39" Background

- Cut two 8 1/2" strips by WOF. Cross cut into (26) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles.
- Cut two 8 1/2" strips by WOF.
- Cut two 2 1/2" strips by WOF. Cross cut into (4) 12 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles.

Sew the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" green strips to both sides of each of the (14) 4 1/2" Amaryllis blocks. Press to the green.



Sew a 2 1/2" red strip to the top and bottom of the (2) 4 1/2" green strips. Press to the green. Crosscut every 2 1/2" to make (28) three part units. Sew these to the top and bottom of the units you just made. Press.

For Block 1B: Sew the 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" background units to both sides of all 14 of the blocks you just finished . Press to the block. Sew the 12 1/2" x 2 1/2" background strips to the top and bottom of two blocks to make blocks like the one above right. You will have 12 blocks left over.

For Block 1A: Sew the remaining 2 1/2" red strips to the top and bottom of the remaining 8 1/2" background strips. Press to the red. Crosscut every 2 1/2" to make (24) three part units. Sew these to the top and bottom of the remaining twelve blocks to make blocks like the one above left.
