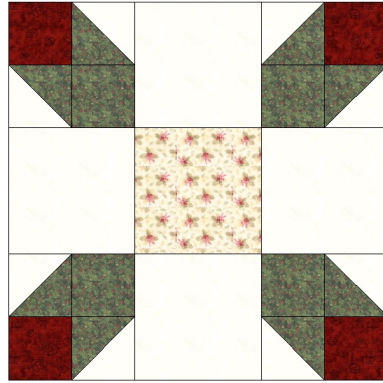


Block Three



Make Eight, 12 1/2" unfinished

Fabric Requirements

4 1/2" Amaryllis

- Cut one 4 1/2 strip by WOF (width of fabric), then crosscut into (8) 4 1/2" squares.

5" Deep Red

- Cut two 2 1/2" strips by WOF, then crosscut into (32) 2 1/2" squares

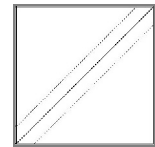
14" Deep Green

- Cut two 2 1/2" strips by WOF, then crosscut into (32) 2 1/2" squares
- Cut three 3" strips by WOF, then crosscut into (32) 3" squares

27" Background

- Cut three 3" strips by WOF, then crosscut into (32) 3" squares
- Cut four 4 1/2" strips by WOF, then crosscut into (32) 4 1/2" squares

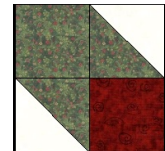
Draw a line on the diagonal on the back of each 3" background square. Match it right sides together with a 3" green square. Sew 1/4" on either side of the line. Cut on the line and press to the dark. Clip your dog ears and square up your blocks to 2 1/2". You will make 64 HST (half square triangle) blocks.



Using half of the HST blocks you just made and the 32 deep green 2 1/2" squares, make 32 two-patches like the one to the left.



Using the remaining HST's and the 32 deep red 2 1/2" squares, make 32 units like the one to the right. Press.



Sew 32 blocks like the one to right. Press and square it up to 4 1/2".

Sew one of these to each side of a 4 1/2" background square. These will be the top and bottom rows in the block above. Make 16 three part units. Press to the center.

Sew a 4 1/2" Amaryllis block between two 4 1/2" background blocks. Press away from the center. Using this as the center row of your block, use the rows you made in the last step to make 8 blocks like the one at the top of the page. Press.
