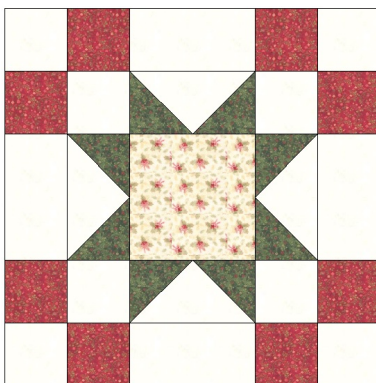


Block Two



Make Five, 12 1/2" unfinished

Fabric Requirements

4 1/2" Amaryllis

- Cut one 4 1/2 strip by width of fabric (WOF), then crosscut into (5) 4 1/2" squares.

10" Red

- Cut four 2 1/2" strips by WOF

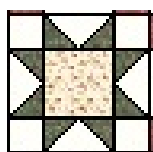
7" Green

- Cut one 7" strip by WOF, then crosscut into (5) 7" squares.

22" Background

- Cut one 5 1/2" strip by WOF, then crosscut into (5) 5 1/2" squares.
- Cut three 2 1/2" strips by WOF, then crosscut into (40) 2 1/2" squares.
- Cut two 4 1/2" strips by WOF.

To make the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" (unfinished) Flying Geese blocks, follow the directions on the Large QIAD Flying Geese Ruler using the five 7" green squares and the five 5 1/2" background squares. For more information on using this ruler, visit <http://www.quiltbug.com/flying-geese.htm>



Sew a Flying Geese block to both sides of the (5) 4 1/2" Amaryllis squares. Sew a 2 1/2" background square on both ends of the remaining Flying Geese blocks. Press to the Flying Geese block. Sew this unit to the top and bottom of the units you just made to make a block like the one to the left.

Sew a 2 1/2" red strip to the top and bottom of both 4 1/2" wide background strips. Press to the red. Crosscut these every 2 1/2" into (20) three part units. Sew half these units to both sides of the star blocks you just made.



Sew a 2 1/2" background square to both ends of the remaining three piece units. Sew these units to the top and bottom of the blocks you just made to make a block like the one at the top of the page.
